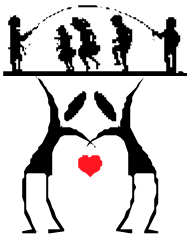

## V.B.R. FOSTER FAMILY AGENCY

Our program includes children of all ages with a variety of special needs including but not limited to, drug exposed infants, Physical and sexual abuse, attention deficit disorders, behavioral emotional disorders and medically fragile children.



## V.B.R.'s PURPOSE:

To recruit and train parents who can offer a nurturing, supportive and creative environment for children. Our foster parents are also given intensive training prior to receiving a child in placement and following placement. These children have "special needs", ages birth to eighteen, and are in need of new families, whether it be short or long term foster placement. Our goal is to provide these children with an appropriate family match and give the families support and training to ensure that these placements will be beneficial in meeting the children's needs. We then provide casework services and specific treatment to each child as specified in the treatment plan.



## SOME OF OUR SERVICES:

- ?? Transportation Assistance: In case of emergencies or scheduling difficulties, the foster parent and/or social worker will assist.
- ?? After Care Services: The agency will provide support for all foster children after they have left the agency by providing any information or documentation in the agency's possession and providing any additional assistance that will help the child after departure.
- ?? Respite Assistance: The agency maintains bed space in several homes to allow for respite placements should foster parents become ill, have an out of town emergency, etc. The staff arranges the respite, may assist with transportation, and ensure all services are maintained during respite such as school and therapy.
